

## DRESS CODE POLICY



- Students are expected to follow the dress code & may be asked to leave the classroom if not dressed properly
  - Hair must be worn pulled back away from the face (see specific class details below)
  - Dance is a discipline that begins with the way a student dresses for class and promotes unity
  - A neat & tidy appearance sets an attitude of attentiveness and respect for students, teachers, and the art of dance
  - Teachers must be able to see a dancer's alignment, lines, and positioning from head to toe to make the proper corrections when needed
  - Jewelry is discouraged to be worn during class except for small earrings. Please keep these items with the parent or at home.
  - ALL dancers are highly recommended to purchase a dance bag to bring with them. Bags are available for purchase at the studio
  - **Please check to make sure that all articles of clothing, shoes, water bottles are picked up before leaving the studio.**
- ALL unclaimed items will be donated if not claimed within 30 days!**

***Dance attire listed below is the same for all genders except where noted***

### PRESCHOOL/COMBO CLASSES (Mini Stars, Tiny Tykes & Kinder Kidz)

Dancers should bring a small dance bag into the dance studio, so tap/ballet shoes can be stored out of the way and aren't misplaced when changing from style to style.

Girls: Solid color leotard (Pink) pink footed tights. No leotards with designs or costumes. Small ballet skirts or tutus are permitted. **Hair must be in a bun!!** Pink ballet shoes & black tap shoes.

Boys: Black sweat/jogger pants or shorts, white or black fitted t-shirt, black ballet shoes & black tap shoes.

### ALL ACRO CLASSES

Girls: Form fitting dance wear (ie. Leotards, tanks, leggings)

Boys: T-Shirt (Not too baggy) and Shorts.

Shoes: Barefoot

### BALLET CLASSES

Solid color black leotard, pink tights and pink/black ballet shoes. Ballet skirt is optional No Bootie shorts. No ponytails allowed. **Hair must be worn in a bun with bobby pins.** Dancers in Ballet III must get approval from teacher before dancing in Pointe shoes.

### BROADWAY HEELS CLASS

Approved character shoes. Please have teacher approve shoes before purchasing.

### DISNEY DANCE CLASSES

Regular dance attire preferred (ie. leotard, leggings, tanks, shorts) T-Shirt/Shorts allowed but not too baggy.

Shoes: Barefoot, Pink (girls), Black (boys) Ballet slippers or Athletic shoes (preferably black or white and soles must be white) to start. One of these three options will be selected for Recital but to start, any of the three are acceptable.

### HIP HOP

Comfortable dance clothing. T-shirts, tank tops, sweat pants, shorts etc. Athletic shoes (preferably black or white). **SOLES MUST BE WHITE!!**

### JAZZ | POP-UP STYLE CLASSES

Form fitted dance wear. Tank tops, leotards, leggings, shorts etc. **NO JEAN SHORTS.** Hair must be pulled up or back. Jazz shoes must be worn (TAN).

### LYRICAL | CONTEMPORARY | YOUNG ARTISTS | ALL TECHNIQUE TYPE CLASSES (Leaps/Turns, Flexibility, Technique)

Form fitted dance wear. Tank tops, form fitting tops, leotards, dance pants, shorts etc. Turning shoes or barefoot.

### MUSICAL THEATRE | DISNEY DANCE CLASSES

Regular dance attire preferred (ie. Leotard, leggings, tanks, shorts) T-Shirt/Shorts allowed but not too baggy.

Shoes: Tan Jazz Shoes

### TAP CLASSES

Comfortable dance clothing. t-shirts, tank tops, leggings, shorts. Black tap shoes (check with teacher).
